

Wye Valley Riding Club Training Weekend
17th-18th July

Please read this information carefully, as there are changes to the weekend.

*******NO FLU VAC CERTIFICATES NEEDED*******

Venue: Howick Farm, Chepstow, Monmouthshire.

The facilities available include – grass dressage arenas, show jumping (course and grid work area) and full cross-country course (The Riding Club Area Horse Trials will be held here the previous weekend).

Format: Instruction will be in small groups of four riders and will last 1 hour with the exception of cross-country, which will be 2 hours with six riders. When applying you are able to choose what you would like to take part in and how many sessions you would like to attend each day. All aspects of training will be covered for all abilities from the experienced to the downright terrified.

Instruction: Instruction will start each day at 9am and continue to around 5pm. Instructors include Sally Williams, Sarah Spencer-Williams, Steve Arnett, Nick Coles, Andrew Bennie and Jane Davies.

Costs:

1 hour sessions (4 riders) = £25 if only one session booked over entire weekend. £20 if more than 1 session booked.

2 hour sessions (6 riders) = £35 if this is the only session you are doing all weekend reduced to £30 if other sessions are undertaken.

For example 2 x 1hour session plus 1 x 2 hour session would be **2 x £20 + 1 x £30 = £70.**

Or 1 x 2 hour session only would be £35.

Paramedic: A Paramedic will be on site all weekend this is included in the cost.

Safety: Hats to current standards are to be worn at all times whilst mounted. Body protectors to the current standard are compulsory for cross-country and recommended for all jumping. There will be a paramedic on site.

Vet: There will be a vet on call during the weekend.

Information: Stabling and B&B or camping can be arranged locally at separate cost.

There will be a caterer on site for those wishing to purchase refreshments.

Portaloos will be provided.
