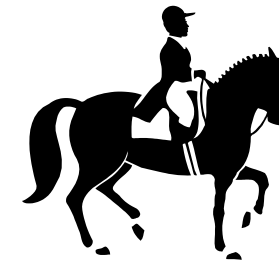


## Rules

1. The Event will be run under British Riding Clubs Competitions Official Rules 2010. It is the Riders' responsibility to familiarise themselves with these rules.
2. Please note the rules for correct Tack and Riders Attire, this will be checked. Hard Hats must be worn at all times when mounted.
3. All Horses/Ponies MUST have up to date Flu Vaccinations in Line with Jockey Club Rules. Please bring Passports/Flu Certificates to Event. Any Horse/Pony without the correct and valid certificate will be eliminated and not allowed to compete.
4. All Persons attending the event do so at their own risk. Vale Of Arrow Riding Club and Kings Equestrian, its officials and agents cannot be held responsible for any accident, theft, loss, Damage, injury or illness, howsoever caused arising out of or at this competition.
5. All persons attending shall be solely responsible for consequences of loss or damage done to or occasioned by, or arising from, any animal and indemnify the Vale Of Arrow Riding Club, Officials, Agents and Kings Equestrian against all damages, actions, claims, proceedings, costs and or expense in relation to or arising from his/her entries in the show. Children under 16 must be under adults supervision at all times.
6. Horses or Ponies must be 4 years of age and over.
7. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to any class without explanation. The Committee cannot be held responsible for any error in the time schedule and reserve the right to amend/alter/cancel any class.
8. Dogs must be on leads at all times.
9. Area 15 Qualifier Pairs/Individuals must be declared at least 30 minutes prior to each class commencing.
10. Health, Safety & Welfare, The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all Officials and Stewards.
11. It is a condition of entry that all the above rules must be complied with.
